The Mayflower: Journey to a New Life

Nearly 400 years ago, a group of people left Europe to seek religious freedom. They made a treacherous voyage across the Atlantic Ocean on a ship called the Mayflower. Learn about the Mayflower and its journey to America with lessons and activities across the grades!

In the early 1600s, the Pilgrims, also known as the Separatists, broke away from the Church of England to establish their own church. Some of the Separatists moved to Holland to escape persecution and to find religious freedom. They settled in the town of Leiden (also known as Leyden), where they stayed for about 12 years. Frustrated by their poor economic conditions in Holland, the Separatists decided to leave Europe and start a colony in America.

With the help of merchant investors, the Pilgrims got a charter to start a new colony. The Pilgrims left Holland on the Speedwell, a
