Arrange	to put in order; especially to put in a particular order (arrange books on shelves)
Browse	to read or look over something (as in a book or a store) in a light or casual way
Category	one of the divisions or groupings used in a system of classification
Classification	systematic arrangement in groups
Collection	something gathered together especially an accumulation of objects gathered for study, comparison, or exhibition
Diorama	a scenic representation in which lifelike sculptured figures and surrounding details are realistically set against a painted background
Division	a part or portion of a whole
Librarian	a person in charge of a library
Literature	written works having excellence of form or expression and ideas of lasting and widespread interest
Nonfiction	literature that is not imaginary or made up
Organize	to put into order
Philosophy	the study of the basic ideas about knowledge, truth, right and wrong, God, and the nature and meaning of life
Psychology	the science or study of mind and behavior
Proponent	one who argues in favor of something
Subdivision	one of the parts of something that has been divided into more parts
Subject	the person or thing discussed
System	an orderly plan or method of governing or arranging
